Students will be encouraged to analyse security issues from multiple perspectives across physical and logical boundaries.</p> <p>At the end of this subject, students should also have improved their collaborative work, research and analytical skills.</p>
Assessment:	Ongoing assessment of project work throughout the semester (40%); a 3-hour written examination in the examination period (60%). Satisfactory completion of both project work and the examination is necessary to pass the subject.
