Students undertaking combined honours in Indonesian must complete: # Indonesian Thesis (37.5 points); and # Two subjects in honours-level Indonesian studies (25 points); and # Three subjects in the combining discipline (25 points). Or # Honours thesis in the combining discipline (37.5 points); and # Critical Asian Perspectives (12.5 points); and # Two subjects in the combining discipline (25 points); and # Two subjects in Indonesian studies (37.5 points).
