It comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"># two level one subjects in any area of study (25 points); and# six level two/three subjects in social theory (totalling 75 points), which must include three of the following five core subjects, and three subjects from the list of elective subjects below. <p>Students who commenced their degree before 2007 will need to complete 112.5 points toward this major in order to complete the major.
