It comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"># two first-year subjects in criminology (25 points); and# three second-year subjects in criminology (37.5 points), including the compulsory subject MULT20003 Critical Analytical Skills; and# three third-year subjects (37.5 points). <p>Students who commenced their degree before 2007 will need to complete 112.5 points toward this major in order to complete the major.
