Course 105AA is no longer taking applications.  German has more than 100 million native speakers and is the third most popular of language world-wide. A knowledge of German opens up the rich culture of Germa Europe as well as its history, philosophy, literature, music and scientific traditions. Studies Program has a proud history of more than half a century at the University and provides students with the opportunity to complete part of their studies overse scholarships and exchange programs.  German language subjects are organised in a progressive sequence of units from through to German 10. Students may enter at any point, subject to placement test prerequisites, and normally progress through the sequence in consecutive order. progression is possible with the permission of the course convenor. Mid-year entry possible into subjects with even numbers.  See course objectives.  Structure & Available Subjects:  A 100-point major sequence is available.
