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Overview:	Japanese language subjects are organised in a progressive sequence (of units). Entry and exit points are determined by the student's background in the language, placement testing, prerequisites, or at the discretion of the language program. Students normally progress through the subjects in consecutive order. Mid-year entry is also possible into subjects with even numbers, subject to appropriate prior experience and approval from the Convenor of the language program. Structure & Available Subjects:	<b>Duration:</b> The Graduate Diploma in Arts in this area of specialisation is only available part-time and normally takes 2 - 3 years to complete. This specialisation is not available to international students.  There are four standard entry points:
	Japanese 1 Entry Point: Students who have never studies Japanese before or have only rudimentary knowledge of the language usually enter the progression at Japanese 1
	Japanese 3 Entry Point: Students who have completed VCE Japanese (Second Language), IB or have an equivalent language level usually enter the progression at Japanese 3
	Japanese 5 Entry Point: Students who perform at an intermediate level in Japanese, for example those who have completed VCE or IB with excellent results or have an equivalent language level usually enter the progression at Japanese 5
	<b>Japanese 7 Entry Point:</b> Students who perform at an advanced level in Japanese, for example those who hold N3 of JLPT (Japanese Language Proficiency Test) or have lived or studied in Japan usually enter the progression at Japanese 7
