Subject Overview:	The emphasis in this subject is on the writing of some of the major contemporary women writers of Spain and Latin America. Assessment:	Two 1500 to 2000-word essays 80% and a 15 to 20-minute oral 20%. For 4th-year students greater achievement and application of research skills and a longer presentation will be required.
