<b>Overview:</b>	<p>The minimum entry requirement for classical studies &amp; archaeology honours is completion of all the requirements for the BA, with completion of a major in classical studies &amp; archaeology, and an average grade over the second/third year subjects within the major equivalent to at least an H2B (70%).</p> <p><b>Students undertaking pure honours in classical studies and archaeology must complete:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># Classical Studies and Archaeology Thesis (37.5 points); and</li> <li># Five honours subjects in classical studies and archaeology (62.5 points).</li> </ul> <p>Students may substitute up to two of these subjects with Latin and/or ancient Greek (intermediate and/or advanced).</p> <p><b>Students undertaking combined honours in classical studies and archaeology and another discipline must complete:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># Classical Studies and Archaeology Thesis (37.5 points); and</li> <li># Two honours subjects in classical studies and archaeology (25 points); and</li> <li># Three honours subjects in the combining discipline (37.5 points).</li> </ul> <p>or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># Honours thesis in the combining discipline (37.5 points); and</li> <li># Two honours subjects in the combining discipline (25 points); and</li> <li># Three honours subjects in classical studies and archaeology (37.5 points).</li> </ul>
