<b>Overview:</b>	<p>The minimum entry requirement for classics honours is completion of all the requirements for the BA, with completion of a major in classics, and an average grade over the second/third year subjects within the major equivalent to at least an H2B (70%).</p> <p><b>Students undertaking pure honours in classics must complete:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># Classics Thesis (37.5 points); and</li> <li># Four honours subjects in ancient Greek and/or Latin (intermediate and/or advanced) (50 points); and</li> <li># One elective subject from the list below (12.5 points).</li> </ul> <p>No more than 25 points of intermediate ancient Greek and Latin subjects may be taken.
