Overview:	<p>The minimum entry requirement for criminology honours is completion of all the requirements for the BA, with a major in criminology and an average grade over the second/third year subjects within the major equivalent to at least an H2A (75%).</p> <p>Students undertaking pure honours in criminology must complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # Criminology Thesis (37.5 points); and # Social Science Research Seminar; and # 50 points of elective subjects. <p>Students undertaking combined honours in criminology and another program must complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # Criminology Thesis (37.5 points); and # Social Science Research Seminar; and # A fourth-year elective in criminology (12.5 points); and # Three fourth-year subjects in the combining discipline (totalling 37.5 points). <p>or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # Honours thesis in the combining discipline (37.5 points); and # Two fourth-year subjects in the combining discipline (totalling 25 points); and # 37.5 points of elective fourth-year subjects in criminology.
