<b>Overview:</b>	<p>The minimum entry requirement for history honours is completion of all the requirements for the BA, with a major in history, and an average grade over the second/third year subjects within the major equivalent to at least an H2B (70%).</p> <p><b>Students undertaking pure honours in history must complete:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># History Thesis (37.5 points); and</li> <li># Five honours subjects in history (totalling 62.5 points).</li> </ul> <p><b>Students undertaking combined honours in history and another program must complete:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># History Thesis (37.5 points); and</li> <li># Two honours subjects in history (totalling 25 points); and</li> <li># Three honours subjects in the combining discipline (totalling 37.5 points).</li> </ul> <p>or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># Honours thesis in the combining discipline (37.5 points); and</li> <li># Two honours subjects in the combining discipline (totalling 25 points); and</li> <li># Three honours subjects in history (totalling 37.5 points).</li> </ul>
