Overview:	<p>The minimum entry requirement for International studies honours is completion of all the requirements for the BA, with a major in International studies and an average grade over the second/third year subjects within the major equivalent to at least an H2A (75%).</p> <p>Students undertaking pure honours in international studies complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # International Studies Thesis (37.5 points); and # Social Science Research Seminar; and # International Politics; and # Three honours subjects from the specified list of approved international studies subjects (37.5 points). <p>Students undertaking combined honours in international studies and another program complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # International Studies Thesis (37.5 points); and # Social Science Research Seminar; and # International Politics; and # Two honours subjects from the combining discipline (25 points). <p>or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # Honours thesis in the combining discipline (37.5 points); and # Two subjects in the combining discipline (25 points); and # Three honours subjects from the specified list of approved international studies subjects (37.5 points).
