<b>Overview:</b>	<p><b>Classical Studies and Archaeology</b></p> <p>A major in <b>classical studies and archaeology</b> usually consists of eight 12.5-point subjects, totalling 100 points. It comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># one first-year subject in classical studies and archaeology and/or ancient Greek and/or Latin (12.5 points); and</li> <li># second/third-year subjects in classical studies and archaeology and/or ancient Greek and/or Latin (totalling 87.5 points).</li> </ul> <p><b>Classics</b></p> <p>A major in <b>classics</b> usually consists of eight 12.5-point subjects, totalling 100 points. It comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># one first-year subject in classical studies and archaeology and/or ancient Greek and/or Latin (12.5 points); and</li> <li># second/third-year subjects in classical studies and archaeology and/or ancient Greek and/or Latin (totalling 87.5 points); and</li> <li># at least 50 points of the major must be ancient Greek and/or Latin subjects.</li> </ul> <p><b>See the Classics major in the new generation for the full list of Ancient Greek and Latin subjects.</b></p> <p>Students who commenced their degree before 2007 will need to complete 112.5 points in these majors in order to complete either major.
