<b>Overview:</b>	<p>The Bachelor of Arts major in Creative Writing usually consists of eight 12.5-point subjects, totalling 100 points. It comprises:</p> <p><i>Level 1</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># 106-105 Creative Writing: Ideas and Practice</li> <li># it is highly recommended that students wishing to continue with a major in creative writing also consider undertaking a first year subject in English literary studies;</li> </ul> <p><i>Level 2/3</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># seven second/third-year subjects (87.5 points). At least four of these subjects must be taken from the following approved creative writing subjects. A maximum of three subjects can consist of any core second/third-year subjects offered in the cultural studies program or English literary studies program.</li> </ul> <p>Students who commenced their degree before 2007 will need to complete 112.5 points toward this major in order to complete the major.
