Subject Options:	<p>Psychology major</p> <p>An undergraduate Australian Psychology Accreditation Council (APAC) - accredited psychology major is a prerequisite for any student wishing to undertake further study to become a practicing psychologist. A three-year accredited psychology major requires the completion of a minimum of 125 credit points worth of undergraduate psychology subjects. This requires the completion of nine compulsory subjects and at least one elective subject. All subjects are worth 12.5 points.</p> <p>Further information on the structure of the accredited psychology major is available on the School of Behavioural Science (http://www.psych.unimelb.edu.au/) website.</p> <p>Although the major study in psychology only requires 37.5 points at third year level, all undergraduate science students must complete a minimum of 50 points of third year level science subjects to satisfy their degree requirements.</p>
