Structure & Available Subjects:	<p>Students undertaking pure honours in Chinese must complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # Chinese Thesis (37.5 points); # Critical Asian Perspectives (12.5 points); # Honours Chinese A (12.5 points); # Honours Chinese B (12.5 points); # Topics in Chinese Studies (12.5 points); and # 12.5 points of elective subjects: selected from Supervised Reading (Asia Institute), Chinese Society and Culture, Cultural Studies in Asia, Asia Pacific: Zone of Conflict of Peace? <p>Students undertaking combined honours in Chinese must complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # Chinese Thesis (37.5 points); # Critical Asian Perspectives (12.5 points); # Two subjects in honours-level Chinese studies (25 points); and # Two subjects in the combining discipline (25 points). <p>Or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # Honours thesis in the combining discipline (37.5 points); # Two subjects in the combining discipline (25 points); and # Three subjects in Chinese (37.5 points). <p>Total 100 points</p>
