Structure & Available Subjects:	<p>Students undertaking pure honours in history must complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # History Thesis (37.5 points); and # History for Historians (12.5 points); and # Four honours subjects (seminars) in history (50 points). <p>Students undertaking combined honours in history and another program must complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # History Thesis (37.5 points); and # Two honours subjects in history (25 points); and # Three honours subjects in the combining discipline (37.5 points). <p>or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # Honours thesis in the combining discipline (37.5 points); and # Two honours subjects in the combining discipline (25 points); and # Three honours subjects in history (37.5 points). <p>Total 100 points</p>
