<b>Overview:</b>	<p>This major is only available to students in the pre-2008 Bachelor of Arts.</p> <p>A major in anthropology usually consists of eight 12.5 point subjects, totalling 100 points. It comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># two first year subjects: Anthropology Studying Human Diversity, and an Arts interdisciplinary subject; and</li> <li># three second/third year level subjects selected from the core subjects list; and</li> <li># three second/third year level subjects from either the core or optional lists.</li> </ul> <p>Students who commenced their degree before 2007 will need to complete 112.5 points toward this major in order to complete the major.
