Students intending to major in Economics should note that Mathematical Methods is a prerequisite for this program. Introductory Microeconomics must be completed before entering Introductory Macroeconomics, Level Two Intermediate Macroeconomics and Intermediate Microeconomics.</p> <p>75 points of this major, and all 75 points of the minor are taken as part of the breadth component of the BA.
