<b>Overview:</b>	<p>The minimum entry requirement for environmental studies honours is completion of all the requirements for the BA, with a major in environmental studies and an average grade over the second/third year subjects within the major equivalent to at least an H2A (75%).</p> <p>It is not possible to complete honours in environmental studies on a part-time basis. Students must complete the honours year full-time over two consecutive semesters of study.</p>
