Structure & Available Subjects:	<p>Students undertaking pure honours in Indonesian must complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # Indonesian Thesis (37.5 points); and # Critical Asian Perspectives (12.5 points); and # Honours Indonesian A (12.5 points); and # Honours Indonesian B (12.5 points); and # 25 points of elective subjects: selected from Supervised Reading (Asia Institute), Topics in Indonesian Studies, History, Memory & Violence in Asia, Human Rights in Southeast Asia, Cultural Studies in Asia, Gender in Cross-Cultural Perspective. <p>Students undertaking combined honours in Indonesian must complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # Indonesian Thesis (37.5 points); and # Two subjects in honours-level Indonesian studies (25 points); and # Three subjects in the combining discipline (25 points). <p>Or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # Honours thesis in the combining discipline (37.5 points); and # Critical Asian Perspectives (12.5 points); and # Two subjects in the combining discipline (25 points); and # Two subjects in Indonesian studies (37.5 points). <p>Total 100 points</p>
