| Structure & Available Subjects: | <p>A major in Australian studies usually consists of eight 12.5-point subjects, totalling 100 points. It comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # two first-year subjects (25 points) which must focus upon Australia or be taken from the list of first-year subjects in Australian studies below; and # six second/third-year subjects in Australian studies (75 points), which must include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # three subjects from the list of core subjects below; and # three subjects from the list of optional subjects below. <p>Students who wish to include a subject that is not listed must seek approval from the convener of the Australian studies program.</p> <p>Students who commenced their degree before 2007 will need to complete 112.5 points toward this major in order to complete the major.
