<b>Structure &amp; Available Subjects:</b>	<p><b>Requirements for a major</b></p> <p>A major in history usually consists of eight 12.5-point subjects, totalling 100 points. It comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># One first-year subject in history (12.5 points); and</li> <li># Seven second/third-year subjects in history (87.5 points).</li> </ul> <p>Students who commenced their degree before 2007 will need to complete 112.5 points toward this major in order to complete the major.
