<b>Structure &amp; Available Subjects:</b>	<p><b>Social Theory</b></p> <p>A major in social theory consists of eight 12.5-point subjects, totalling 100 points. It comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># two level one subjects in any area of study (25 points); and</li> <li># six level two/three subjects in social theory (totalling 75 points), which must include three of the following five core subjects, and three subjects from the list of elective subjects below.</li> </ul> <p>Students who commenced their degree before 2007 will need to complete 112.5 points toward this major in order to complete the major.
