<b>Structure &amp; Available Subjects:</b>	<p>Swedish</p> <p>A major in Swedish usually consists of 112.5 points comprising:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># first-year subjects in Swedish (25 points); and</li> <li># second-year subjects in Swedish (37.5 points); and</li> <li># third-year subjects in Swedish (50 points).</li> </ul> <p>Students who commenced their degree before 2007 will need to complete 112.5 points toward this major in order to complete the major. For the specific major structure you must follow, refer to the handbook produced in the year you commenced your degree, available online at <a href="https://psc.unimelb.edu.au/">https://psc.unimelb.edu.au/</a> (<a href="https://psc.unimelb.edu.au/">https://psc.unimelb.edu.au/</a>). Students who commenced in 2007 and have completed 37.5 points of Swedish the first year of their language stream will usually need to complete 37.5 points at second year and 37.5 at third year to complete a Swedish language major.
