Structure & Available Subjects:	<p>Economics</p> <p>The Department of Economics in the Faculty of Business and Economics offer a 112.5-point major and 75-point minor in the BA. Students intending to major in Economics should note that Mathematical Methods is a prerequisite for this program. Introductory Microeconomics must be completed before entering Introductory Macroeconomics, Level Two Intermediate Macroeconomics and Intermediate Microeconomics.</p> <p>Students who undertake a major in Economics will complete 112.5 points with 37.5 points taken as Arts discipline subjects, 50 points taken as breadth and 25 points taken as free subject.
