<b>Overview:</b>	<p>Currently there is no pure honours program in Hebrew or Jewish studies. However, combined honours is available in Jewish studies. This means that students must combine fourth-year honours in Jewish studies with another area of study in the Faculty of Arts at the University of Melbourne.</p> <p>The prerequisites for entry to combined honours in Jewish studies are completion of all the requirements for the BA, with a major in Hebrew studies or a major in Jewish studies which must include two semesters of Hebrew language study and an average grade over the second/ third year subjects within the major equivalent to at least an H2B (70%).</p>
