It comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # two first-year subjects, one of which should be Asia focused, from any program within the Faculty of Arts (25 points); and # the program's compulsory subject CHIN20025 Human Rights in China & East Asia (12.5 points); and # five subjects (62.5 points) from the list of Asian studies subjects below, ASIA30002 Identity, Ideology & Nationalism in Asia is strongly recommended. <p>Students who commenced their degree before 2007 will need to complete 112.5 points toward this major in order to complete the major.
