Structure & Available Subjects:	<p>Classical Studies and Archaeology</p> <p>A major in Classical Studies and Archaeology usually consists of eight 12.5-point subjects, totalling 100 points. It comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # one first-year subject in Classical Studies and Archaeology and/or ancient Greek and/or Latin (12.5 points); and # second/third-year subjects in Classical Studies and Archaeology and/or ancient Greek and/or Latin (totalling 87.5 points). <p>Classics</p> <p>A major in Classics usually consists of eight 12.5-point subjects, totalling 100 points. It comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # one first-year subject in Classical Studies and Archaeology and/or ancient Greek and/or Latin (12.5 points); and # second/third-year subjects in Classical Studies and Archaeology and/or ancient Greek and/or Latin (totalling 87.5 points); and # at least 50 points of the major must be ancient Greek and/or Latin subjects. <p>Students who commenced their degree before 2007 will need to complete 112.5 points in these majors in order to complete either major.
