<b>Structure &amp; Available Subjects:</b>	<p>Students undertaking pure Honours in Anthropology &amp; Social Theory must complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># A Thesis of 15,000 words (50 points) and</li> <li># One compulsory subject (12.5 points) and</li> <li># Two core subjects (25 points) and</li> <li># One elective subject (12.5 points)</li> </ul> <p>Students undertaking combined Honours must complete one of the following options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># A 15,000 word anthropology thesis (50 points) and</li> <li># Philosophy and Scope of Anthropology (12.5 points) and</li> <li># Coursework from the combining discipline (equivalent to 37.5 points)</li> </ul> <p>Or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># Thesis in the combining discipline (37.5 points) and</li> <li># Coursework from the combining discipline (25 points) and</li> <li># Philosophy and Scope of Anthropology (12.5 points) and</li> <li># Two anthropology electives from the elective list (equivalent to 25 points)</li> </ul>
