Structure & Available Subjects:	<p>Students undertaking pure honours in Japanese must complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # Japanese Thesis (37.5 points); and # Critical Asian Perspectives (12.5 points); and # Honours Japanese A (12.5 points); and # Honours Japanese B (12.5 points); and # 25 points of elective subjects: selected from Supervised Reading (Asia Institute), Topics in Japanese Studies, World War Two in Asia & the Pacific, Cultural Studies in Asia, Asia Pacific: Zone of Conflict or Peace? <p>Students undertaking combined honours in Japanese and another discipline must complete:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # Japanese Thesis (37.5 points); and # Two Japanese studies honours language subjects (25 points); and # Three honours subjects in the combining discipline (37.5 points) <p>or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # Honours thesis in the combining discipline (37.5 points); and # Two honours subjects in the combining discipline (25 points); and # Two advanced Japanese language subjects (25 points); and # One Japanese studies honours elective subject (12.5 points). <p>Total 100 points</p>
