It comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # one first-year subject in cinema studies (12.5 points); and # second/third-year subjects in cinema studies (87.5 points) <p>Students wishing to vary their program must consult with the coordinator.</p> <p>Students who commenced their degree before 2007 will need to complete 112.5 points in order to complete the major.
