<b>Year and Campus:</b>	2013									
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<b>Overview:</b>	Indonesian language subjects are organised in a progressive sequence (of units). Entry and exit points are determined by the student's background in the language, placement testing, prerequisites, or at the discretion of the language program. Students normally progress through the subjects in consecutive order. Mid-year entry is also possible into subjects with even numbers, subject to appropriate prior experience and approval from the Convenor of the language program.

<b>Structure &amp; Available Subjects:</b>	<p><b>Duration and Credit Points</b></p> <p>100 credit points. This program is only available part-time and normally takes 2 - 3 years to complete.</p> <p><b>Structure &amp; Available Subjects:</b></p> <p>In the Graduate Diploma language subjects are taken in sequence over 3 years part-time. The standard structure for a Graduate Diploma in language is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># 25 points at level 1</li> <li># 37.5 points at level 2</li> <li># 37.5 points at level 3</li> </ul> <p>Common entry points are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># Indonesian 1 entry point: Students who have never studied Indonesian before or have only rudimentary knowledge of the language usually enter the progression at Indonesian 1</li> <li># Indonesian 3 entry point: Students who have completed VCE Indonesian (Second Language) Standard IB Indonesian or have an equivalent language level usually enter the progression at Indonesian 3</li> <li># Indonesian 5 entry point: Students who perform at an advanced level in Indonesian, for example those who have completed VCE Indonesian (First Language) or have lived or studied in Indonesia, usually enter at Indonesian 5</li> </ul> <p>Students will have their appropriate entry point determined by the Indonesian Program, based on evidence of prior learning and/or results of a placement test as required.
