Structure & Available Subjects:	<p>A major in cultural studies consists of eight 12.5-point subjects, totalling 100 points. It comprises:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # two first-year subjects in anthropology, art history, cinema studies, criminology, cultural studies, English, history, history and philosophy of science, linguistics and applied linguistics, philosophy, political science or sociology (25 points); and # six second/third-year subjects (75 points). <p>A major in cultural studies should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # at least one subject from the list of foundational subjects below; and # at least four subjects from the list of core subjects below; and # a maximum of two approved optional subjects. <p>A student wishing to complete a major without having included one of the foundational subjects must complete a minimum of five core subjects and a maximum of one approved optional subject at second or third year</p> <p>Students who commenced their degree before 2007 will need to complete 112.5 points toward this major in order to complete the major.
