<b>Structure &amp; Available Subjects:</b>	<p><b>Students undertaking pure honours in Islamic studies must complete:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># Islamic Studies Thesis (50 points); and</li> <li># compulsory subject Critical Asian Perspectives (12.5 points); and</li> <li># at least two core subjects (25 points); and</li> <li># a maximum of one elective, to total 100 points.</li> </ul> <p><b>Students undertaking combined honours in Islamic studies must complete:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># Islamic Studies Thesis (50 points); and</li> <li># compulsory subject Critical Asian Perspectives (12.5 points); and</li> <li># one core subject in Islamic studies (12.5 points); and</li> <li># two subjects in the combining discipline (25 points).</li> </ul> <p><b>Or</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># Honours thesis in the combining discipline (37.5 points); and</li> <li># two subjects in the combining discipline (25 points); and</li> <li># compulsory subject Critical Asian Perspectives (12.5 points); and</li> <li># two core Islamic studies subjects (25 points).</li> </ul> <p>Total 100 points</p>
