Overview:	German has more than 100 million native speakers and is the third most popular foreign language world-wide. A knowledge of German opens up the rich culture of German-speaking Europe as well as its history, philosophy, literature, music and scientific traditions. The German Studies Program has a proud history of more than half a century at the University of Melbourne and provides students with the opportunity to complete part of their studies overseas through scholarships and exchange programs.

Structure & Available Subjects:	<p>Duration: Depending on entry point, the Graduate Diploma in Arts (German) must be taken part-time over at least two years (usually three years).</p> <p>Please note: German language subjects are organised in a progressive sequence of units from German 1 through to German 10. Student may enter at any points, subject to placement testing and/or prerequisites, and normally progress through the sequence in consecutive order. Mid-year entry is also possible into subjects with even numbers.</p> <p>There are four standard entry points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # German 1 Entry Point: for students who have very little or no knowledge of German # German 3 Entry Point: for students who have undertaken four or five years of secondary school German or who have obtained a VCE German score of 32 or below (or equivalent) # German 5 Entry Point: for students who have obtained a VCE German score of 33 or above (or equivalent) # German 7 Entry Point: German 7 entry point: for native speakers or near-native speakers of German, or for candidates who have spent a number of years in a German speaking country <p>The Graduate Diploma in Arts in this area of specialisation requires:</p> <p>German 1 Entry Point</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # eight compulsory subjects (100 points) <p>German 3 Entry Point</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # seven compulsory subjects (87.5 points) # one Level 3 elective subject (12.5 points) <p>German 5 Entry Point</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # six compulsory subjects (75 points) # two Level 3 elective subjects (25 points) <p>German 7 Entry Point</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> # six compulsory subjects (75 points) # two Level 3 European Studies elective subjects (25 points) <p>Total 100 points</p> <p>Please note: Students will have their appropriate entry point determined by the German Program, based on evidence of prior learning and/or results of a placement test as required.
