<b>Structure &amp; Available Subjects:</b>	<p><b>Economics</b></p> <p>The Department of Economics in the Faculty of Business and Economics offer a 112.5-point major and 75-point minor in the BA. Students intending to major in Economics should note that Mathematical Methods is a prerequisite for this program. Introductory Microeconomics must be completed before entering Introductory Macroeconomics, Level Two Intermediate Macroeconomics and Intermediate Microeconomics.</p> <p>Students who undertake a major in Economics will complete 112.5 points with 37.5 points taken as Arts discipline subjects, 75 points taken as breadth. Students intending to complete a major in Economics should refer to the <b>sample course plans</b> (<a href="http://www.ba.unimelb.edu.au/ugrad/course_structure.html">http://www.ba.unimelb.edu.au/ugrad/course_structure.html</a>) on the Bachelor of Arts web pages.
