<b>Overview:</b>	<p>The minimum entry requirement for Indonesian honours is completion of all the requirements for the BA, with a major in Indonesian and an average of at least H2A (75%) in second and third-year subjects within the major, or equivalent.</p> <p>The honours program in Indonesian comprises advanced coursework and an individual research project designed to extend students' knowledge and skills in analysing Indonesia related issues.</p>						
<b>Learning Outcomes:</b>	<p>In addition to the overall learning outcomes of the BA (Honours), students completing BA (Honours) in Indonesian Studies will also:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># Demonstrate a detailed knowledge and understanding of key issues in the field of Indonesian Studies;</li> <li># Demonstrate and detailed knowledge of Indonesian language, culture and society and advanced proficiency in reading, writing and communicating fluently in Indonesian.</li> </ul>						
<b>Structure &amp; Available Subjects:</b>	<p><b>Students undertaking pure honours in Indonesian must complete:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># Indonesian Thesis (50 points); and</li> <li># Critical Asian Perspectives (12.5 points); and</li> <li># Honours Indonesian A (12.5 points); and</li> <li># Honours Indonesian B (12.5 points); and</li> <li># One 12.5 point elective subject selected from: Supervised Reading (Asia Institute); Topics in Indonesian Studies; Human Rights in Southeast Asia; or History, Memory &amp; Violence in Asia.</li> </ul> <p><b>Students undertaking combined honours in Indonesian must complete:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># Indonesian Thesis (50 points); and</li> <li># Critical Asian Perspectives (12.5 points); and</li> <li># Three subjects in the combining discipline (37.5 points).</li> </ul> <p>Or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># Honours thesis in the combining discipline (50 points); and</li> <li># One subject in the combining discipline (12.5 points); and</li> <li># Three subjects in Indonesian studies (37.5 points), normally Honours Indonesian A, Honours Indonesian B and one of: topics in Indonesian Studies; Supervised Reading (Asia Institute); Human Rights in Southeast Asia; or History, Memory &amp; Violence in Asia.</li> </ul> <p>Total 100 points</p>
