

## Graduate Diploma in Arts - Indonesian

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<b>Overview:</b>	Indonesian language subjects are organised in a progressive sequence (of units). Entry and exit points are determined by the student's background in the language, placement testing, prerequisites, or at the discretion of the language program. Students normally progress through the subjects in consecutive order. Mid-year entry is also possible into subjects with even numbers, subject to appropriate prior experience and approval from the Convenor of the language program.

<b>Structure &amp; Available Subjects:</b>	<p><b>Duration:</b> The Graduate Diploma in Arts in this area of specialisation language subjects are taken in sequence over 3 years part-time. This specialisation is not available to international students.</p> <p><b>There are three standard entry points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># <b>Indonesian 1 entry point:</b> Students who have never studied Indonesian before or have only rudimentary knowledge of the language usually enter the progression at Indonesian 1</li> <li># <b>Indonesian 3 entry point:</b> Students who have completed VCE Indonesian (Second Language) Standard IB Indonesian or have an equivalent language level usually enter the progression at Indonesian 3</li> <li># <b>Indonesian 5 entry point:</b> Students who perform at an advanced level in Indonesian, for example those who have completed VCE Indonesian (First Language) or have lived or studied in Indonesia, usually enter at Indonesian 5</li> </ul> <p><b>The Graduate Diploma in Arts in this area of specialisation requires:</b></p> <p><b>Indonesian 1 Entry Point</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># two Level 1 compulsory subjects (25 points)</li> <li># three Level 2 compulsory subjects (37.5 points)</li> <li># one Level 3 elective subject (12.5 points)</li> <li># two Level 4 compulsory subjects (25 points)</li> </ul> <p><b>Indonesian 3 Entry Point</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># two Level 1 compulsory subjects (25 points)</li> <li># three Level 2 compulsory subjects (37.5 points)</li> <li># one Level 3 elective subject (12.5 points)</li> <li># two Level 4 compulsory subjects (25 points)</li> </ul> <p><b>Indonesian 5 Entry Point</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li># two Level 1 compulsory subjects (25 points)</li> <li># three Level 2 core subjects (37.5 points)</li> <li># one Level 3 elective subjects (12.5 points)</li> <li># two Level 4 compulsory subjects (25 points)</li> </ul> <p><b>Total 100 points</b></p> <p>Students will have their appropriate entry point determined by the Indonesian Program, based on evidence of prior learning and/or results of a placement test as required.
